Installing Solace event brokers entails complex planning and execution processes. For example, when installing Solace appliances, you need to work with the infrastructure team to set up network provisioning, SAN storage allocation and fiber cable laying. When installing software brokers, picking the underlying virtual infrastructure for computation and storage requires in-depth knowledge of the latest Solace event brokercompatible technologies. Solace Professional Services knows how to plan the installation of Solace event brokers with minimal risk to your production, staging, and testing environments.

This service package also creates an installation report for you and your team, which you can use to perform identical installation or as blueprint for future installation of event brokers when your Solace deployment expands.

Activities Included

The installation package is fixed in scope, covering many aspects of successfully installing PubSub+ deployments, including hardware appliances and software event brokers:

Installation Planning

We work with your application, middleware, and infrastructure teams to plan for the installation of Solace event brokers and drill down to details of what type of storage size/IOPS and network speed are required.
